

The Text:

Larbi Ben M'hidi was born in 1923 in the village of El kouahi, Ain M'lila, Algeria. Commonly known as Si Larbi or simply as Ben M'hidi. He attended a French primary school for his first school year, then transferred to a school in Batna where he finished his studies. In 1939, he joined the Algerian Muslim Scouts. He became a group leader within a very short period of time.

During the Algerian war of independence, he obtained significant responsibilities to fight against French forces. He was one of the six founding members of the National liberation front (FLN). He headed FLN operations during the Battle of Algiers. He was a strong believer of liberty and the revolution should be "internal" rather than "external".

He was captured by the French army in February 1957 and executed. His death was announced in March 4th, 1957 in Algiers, Algeria. Ben m'hidi is a hero for all Algerians. He was a real man who smiles in troubles, gathers strength from distress, and grows brave by reflection. He is such an inspiration that humans can be kind, brave, strong even in the most difficult moments in life.
